My name, language, phone number and payment information. My photos, videos, documents and comments. Ads I watch. Apps I use and how I use them. The devices I use, their unique IDs, settings and operating systems. My mobile network information. If I use Chrome, my browsing history. My search terms and history. Who I know and communicate with. If I use voice features, my voice and the people I talk to. My activity on other sites that use Google Services. Publicly available information about me. Information about me from Google’s partners.

How does Google use my data?

To deliver its services. To develop new products. To give me custom recommendations. To show me targeted ads. To measure how I use the service. To track ad performance. To communicate with me. To make Google safer and more reliable.

What controls do I have?

- I can manage my privacy settings.
- ... check what information Google has about me.
- ... delete my account.
- ... configure my browser so that Google gets less information.

When Does Google Share my Information with Others?

- With my consent, like when I make a post.
- With my school/work if it uses G Suite.
- With Google’s partner companies. Partners are instructed to comply with this privacy policy. Google can change partner companies at any time and they can use my information as they see fit.
- With police for legal reasons

What happens to my data when I delete my account?

I can delete specific content or my entire account, but Google may keep my data for a “legitimate business or legal purpose.”

Where is my data processed?

My data might be processed outside my country. Wherever it goes, this Privacy Policy still applies.

What if the privacy policy changes?

Google won’t reduce your rights without asking you. It will notify you if it makes big changes.
