Who can use YouTube?

You must be >13 and have parental consent if you're <18.
...cannot make fake accounts.
...cannot use someone else's account without permission.
...cannot impersonate someone else.
YouTube can change the Agreement at any time.



Who is responsible for what happens on my account?

You. If YouTube is successfully sued as a result of actions on your account, you will pay its expenses.



What about my content?

Your content
...must have copyright permissions.
...cannot threaten, spam, mislead, scam, harass or bully.
...cannot contain violent, graphic, hateful, nude, or sexual content.
If you break the rules multiple times, YouTube can delete your account.

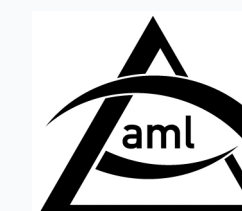


Who owns my content?

You do, but YouTube and other users can use and distribute it.
YouTube can keep your videos after you delete them.
You can delete your comments but YouTube can keep them on file.

What if YouTube causes me harm or damage?

Use at your own risk.
If you want to sue, you must sue within a year of the incident in Santa Clara County, California.
